



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

BETWEEN

UNIVERSITI SAINS ISLAM MALAYSIA (USIM)

AND

UNIVERSITAS MUHAMMADIYAH YOGYAKARTA (UMY)

BETWEEN

UNIVERSITI SAINS ISLAM MALAYSIA, an institution of higher learning incorporated under the Universiti Sains Islam Malaysia (Incorporation Order) 2007 [P.U. (A) 31/2007 and established under the Universities and University Colleges Act 1971 and having its correspondence address at Bandar Baru Nilai, 71800 Nilai, Negeri Sembilan Darul Khusus, Malaysia (hereinafter referred to as "USIM") and will include its lawful representatives and permitted assigns on the one part;

AND

UNIVERSITAS MUHAMMADIYAH YOGYAKARTA, an institution of higher learning in Indonesia and having its correspondence address at Ji. Lingkar Selatan, Kasihan Bantul DIY 55183 (hereinafter referred to as "UMY") and will include its lawful representatives and permitted assigns on the other part;

USIM and **UMY** shall hereinafter be referred to singularly as "the Party" and collectively as "the Parties".

WHEREAS: -

- A. USIM is an established public university in Malaysia which strives to enhance and strengthen its tertiary-level education training in a wide spectrum of academic disciplines via various collaborative arrangements with other parties.
- B. UMY is an established private university in Indonesia which strives in the realization of the noble Muslim scholar and able to develop science and technology for the beneficial of the people, the nation and humanity.
- C. The Parties are desirous of entering into this Memorandum of Understanding to declare their respective intentions and to establish a basis of co-operation and collaboration between the Parties upon the terms as contained herein.

THE PARTIES HAVE REACHED AN UNDERSTANDING as follows:

ARTICLE I

OBJECTIVE

The Parties, subject to the terms of this Memorandum of Understanding and the laws, rules, regulations and national policies from time to time in force in each Party's country, will endeavour to strenghten, promote and develop on a basis of direct cooperation and collaboration in the field of research, education and in training programs on the basis of equality and mutual benefit.

ARTICLE II

AREAS OF COOPERATION

- 1. Each Party will, subject to the laws, rules, regulation and national policies from time to time in force, governing the subject matter in their respective countries, endeavour to take necessary steps to encourage and promote cooperation in the following areas:
 - (a) Administrator Training Programme
 - (b) Administrator Attachment Programme
 - (c) ASEAN Administrator Symposium Seminar
 - (d) Benchmarking Program for USIM's Kluster/Adopted Schools
- For the purpose of implementing the co-operation in respect of any area stated in paragraph 1, the Parties will enter into a legally binding agreement subject to terms and conditions as mutually agreed upon by the Parties including clauses on "confidentiality", "suspension", "protection of intellectual property rights" and "settlement of dispute".

- Each Party shall bear its own cost and expenses in relation to this Memorandum of Understanding.

ARTICLE IV

EFFECT OF MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding serves only as a record of the Parties' intentions and does not constitute or create, and is not intended to constitute or create, obligations under domestic or international law and will not give rise to any legal process and will not deemed to constitute or create any legally binding or enforceable obligations, express or implied.

ARTICLE V

NO AGENCY

Nothing contained herein is to be construed so as to constitute a joint venture partnership or formal business organization of any kind between the Parties or so to constitute either Party as the agent of the other.
